Graffiti removed for Homebase

A Homebase store in Edinburgh had the exterior of their building badly damaged by graffiti, which allowed the local Rainbow office to show how effective their Blast Cleaning system is at removing graffiti and cleaning building façades.

The substantial graffiti 'attack' affected 9 separate areas of the building; meaning there were several different substrates to deal with. Soda Blasting was the media used to blast the graffiti off the building exterior, due to its environmentally friendly nature. Using this media means it was not necessary to use any chemicals, resulting in absolutely no disruption to the store's business.

Soda Blasting is just one of the media that can be used in the Blast Cleaning process, every substrate and environment has different considerations which will determine what medium should be used.

The owner of the Rainbow Edinburgh branch has used the blast cleaning process very effectively on a number of projects for both graffiti removal, removing soot and smoke residue following fire, and general cleaning of building façades.
