Rainbow guarantee match kicks off on time

A severed pipe from a dishwasher caused untold problems for Lincoln City Football Club.

The whole of the executive lounge and bar areas suffered severe water damage. Water had also leaked through the floors of these areas and into the physiotherapy room, referees rest room, store room, clothing room and toilet facilities beneath, causing excessive damage.

This major incident occurred in the early hours of a Friday morning, the following Saturday Lincoln were hosting a match against Darlington, with all corporate hospitality packages sold out and customers waiting to use the affected facilities.

Local Rainbow International branches in Grantham, Lincoln and Newark joined forces on this job, to ensure all affected areas could be restored to pre-incident condition in time for the upcoming game. Technicians from each of the branches were onsite within 2 hours of receiving the instruction, getting to work right away scoping out the damage and formulating a plan of action to get the affected areas fully restored.

Wooden flooring in the affected rooms was uplifted and drying equipment installed to allow for prompt drying of all of the floors. By the following Thursday the drying operation was complete and the wooden floors relaid - all of this was completed with plenty of time to spare before the upcoming football game on the Saturday.
