Ship Shape & Bristol Fashion

Rainbow International on the Isle of Wight brought a nautical addition to their already extensive cleaning portfolio.

A Severn class Lifeboat of the RNLI had just completed a refit and required a pre-handover deep clean prior to returning to active service.

All areas of the craft were cleaned, with particular attention being paid to the cockpit including all of the electronics, the flying bridge, engine rooms and transom.

'Attention to detail' was certainly the operative word on the day, not just for the Rainbow team but also the ships engineer. The boats inspectors had the engineer cutting exposed bolts as they were one thread too large and they all needed to be exactly the same length! Thankfully the boat passed a thorough inspection once the cleaning team had finished.

The lifeboat completed a successful handover and was returned to its station at Newhaven. The Rainbow team looks forward to the next RNLI lifeboat refit.
