



Case History

Building restored following major escape of water in just 10 weeks

Rainbow International's branch in Brackley, received a call from their local NFU Mutual branch following an escape of water at a 4 bedroom house in Buckinghamshire.

Rainbow were advised that the tenants had moved out of the property the week before. An elbow joint pipe in the loft burst resulting in a severe water leak affecting 12 rooms. Within less than 48 hours, Rainbow were on-site completing their Risk Assessment, assessing damage, uplifting and disposing of unrestorable items including floor coverings, collapsed ceiling debris, saturated insulation and peeling paper.

Rainbow International entirely project managed this large job on behalf of NFU Mutual in 10 weeks. The scope of work included the drying of 12 rooms, stripping out works, building/reinstatement works, electrical reinstatement works and replacing damaged flooring. This meant that the policyholder had minimal disruption and only one point of contact rather than numerous contractors completing different aspects of the job.
